RECOMMENDATION OF CONTRACT AWARD

ZEPHYR COVE WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE 2

Contractual Parties: Nevada Tahoe Conservation District (NTCD), MKD Construction

Effective Dates: April 12, 2017 – June 30, 2017

Summary: The Zephyr Cove Water Quality Improvement Project, Phase 2 bids were received on April 4, 2017 and subsequently publically opened. The allocated construction budget provided by the funders (USFS, NDOT, and NDEP) is \$378,171 and the total funding available is \$424,706. NDOT has agreed to provide up to \$55,000 in a contract amendment to cover the additional bid cost as well as possible change orders. Bids were received from 3 qualified bidders with MKD Construction having the lowest bid, closet to the allocated budget and engineer's estimate. NTCD staff reviewed their bid packet and found it to be complete. NTCD checked the references of MKD and found them to be adequate and often excellent. NTCD staff recommends entering into an agreement based on best value with MKD Construction to construct the Zephyr Cove Water Quality Improvement Project, Phase 2 for a contract sum of \$394,102. All permits have been obtained and construction must be completed by June 30, 2017.

I (we) hereby submit my (our) proposal for the "ZEPHYR COVE WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE 2".

In compliance with your published Notice to Contractors, the undersigned as bidder declares that he has carefully examined the location of the proposed work and the Plans and Specifications, including the Special Technical Provisions and the Standard Specifications for Public Works; therefore, together with addenda numbered ______ through ______, and I (we) propose and agree that if this proposal is accepted, I (we) will contract with the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District (NTCD) to provide all necessary labor, machinery, tools, apparatus, and other means of construction, and do all the work and furnish all the materials required to complete construction of the project, in a satisfactory manner at the prices stated in the bid proposal.

Construction shall be in strict conformity with the 100% Design Plans, Special Technical Provisions, Specifications, and contract documents prepared therefore, which hereby are made a part of this proposal.

The bidder proposes and agrees to contract with NTCD to furnish and perform all of the described work, including subsidiary obligations as defined in said contract documents and specifications and to complete the work in the manner and within the time limits set forth in the Contract Documents.

The bidder understands that the following quantities are approximate, only being given as a basis for the comparison of Proposals; and that NTCD does not expressly or by implication agree that the actual amount of work will correspond therewith, but reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount of work as may be deemed necessary or advisable by the Engineer.

The following modifications are hereby made to the Bidding and Contract documents for the above referenced project:

CHANGES TO THE BID DOCUMENTS

ITEM 1: Attached to this document is the document "ADDITIONS TO SOLICITATION DOCUMENTS & SPECIFICATIONS FOR ZEPHYR COVE WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE 2" which shall be considered a part of the bid packet. These additions provided information on the required bonds as well as additional required forms and information on prevailing wages and permits obtained to date.

ITEM 2: In the "Instructions to Bidders," in item number 8, the sentence "Work on USFS Parcel 1318-10-000-002 must be completed by June 2, 2017," should be changed to "Work on USFS Parcel 1318-10-000-002 must be completed by June 15, 2017." Additional US Forest Service permit conditions are available in the Appendix D of the revised Special Technical Provisions attached to this addendum.

ITEM 3: In the "Instructions to Bidders," in item number 8, add the following sentences for the Nevada Department of Transportation right-of-way lane closure requirements "Daytime work and a full single lane closure in US-50 will be allowed up to May 25th. No work will be allowed during holiday weekends and the day before or after on US-50 (May 26th-May 30th). Starting May 31st, night work only will be allowed on US-50. "

ITEM 4: Tree removal of the 15 trees shown on the Plan Sheet C-3 will be performed prior to May 1 by the US Forest Service or a separate NTCD sub-contractor. 3 of these trees will have the stumps also removed. The special technical provisions and bid schedule shall be modified to eliminate tree removal (bid item 5). A new bid schedule is attached or you may cross out bid item 5 on the existing bid schedule. Trees under 6" diameter breast height and removal of 12 larger tree stumps (from the 15 cut trees) should be considered included in the cost for Clearing and Grubbing.

ITEM 5: Amend section 260.04 to include the phrase: "Temporary irrigation must run from the completion of the project through the first freeze or October 31st, 2017, whichever is sooner."

ITEM 6: In the Project Plans, detail 3 on page D-2, shall be amended to include the following note:

11. Trench width of pipe OD + 3' is necessary if the trench will be backfilled with granular backfill. If flowable fill (Class A: excavatable slurry cement per NDOT Specification) is used as backfill like the detail shows, then the trench width can be reduced to pipe OD + 8'' (4" on each side).

ITEM 7: Sheet TC-1, attached to this addendum, shall be incorporated into the project plan set as the base traffic control plan and the minimum required by NDOT.

ITEM 8: There will be an optional pre-bid site meeting on Friday, March 24, 2017 at 2 PM. Please park in the southern lot of the Zephyr Cove Resort (where the staging area is shown on the Project Plans).

CLARIFICATION ITEMS

CLARIFICATION ITEM 1: A signed copy of Addendum 1 shall be attached to and submitted with the bid proposal.

CONDITIONS

CONDITION #1: Final construction and revegetation plans for the project area and temporary staging/access areas must be submitted and approved by the Forest Service prior to construction commencement.

CONDITION #2: Information on each tree to be removed (dbh, species, location) must be submitted and approved. A tree removal permit must be issued before trees can be removed.

CONDITION #3: All trees in the construction area that are not to be removed must be protected with wood board tree protection. Roots must be avoided when possible.

CONDITION #4: Dark-colored concrete and indigenous rock in a variety of sizes must be used in the construction of the headwalls, channels and basins.

CONDITION #5: The edges of the basins and channels must be undulating to minimize the linear charter of these features.

CONDITION #6: Metal used in construction must be treated to reduce reflective or glare-producing impacts.

CONDITION #7: Construction cannot take place between June 15 and Labor Day.

ITEM 1: Attached to this document is the document "ADDITIONS TO SOLICITATION DOCUMENTS & SPECIFICATIONS FOR ZEPHYR COVE WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE 2" which shall be considered a part of the bid packet. These additions provided information on the required bonds as well as additional required forms and information on prevailing wages and permits obtained to date.

ITEM 2: In the "Instructions to Bidders," in item number 8, the sentence "Work on USFS Parcel 1318-10-000-002 must be completed by June 2, 2017," should be changed to "Work on USFS Parcel 1318-10-000-002 must be completed by June 15, 2017." Additional US Forest Service permit conditions are available in the Appendix D of the revised Special Technical Provisions attached to this addendum.

ITEM 3: In the "Instructions to Bidders," in item number 8, add the following sentences for the Nevada Department of Transportation right-of-way lane closure requirements "Daytime work and a full single lane closure in US-50 will be allowed up to May 25th. No work will be allowed during holiday weekends and the day before or after on US-50 (May 26th-May 30th). Starting May 31st, night work only will be allowed on US-50. "

ITEM 4: Tree removal of the 15 trees shown on the Plan Sheet C-3 will be performed prior to May 1 by the US Forest Service or a separate NTCD sub-contractor. 3 of these trees will have the stumps also removed. 


