The following modifications are hereby made to the Bidding and Contract documents for the above referenced project:

CHANGES TO THE BID DOCUMENTS

ITEM 1: On page C-1 of the project plans, the 40" diameter Jeffrey pine will be saved. The rock slope protection will be relocated from near the 16" fir to the 40" Jeffrey pine. No rock slope protection will be needed at the tree cluster near the 16" fir. The contours on the plan will be adjusted accordingly and no additional cut or fill is expected to result.

CLARIFICATION ITEMS

CLARIFICATION ITEM 1: A signed copy of Addendum 1 shall be attached to and submitted with the bid proposal.

CLARIFICATION ITEM 2: Bids received by email have 24 hours from the bid opening to submit a hard copy of the bid bond required to bid the project. The bid bond shall be provided to the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District by 4pm on August 21, 2020 for the bid to be considered eligible.

CLARIFICATION ITEM 3: The bid opening will be broadcast live from the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District office at 4pm on August 20, 2020 at rtmp://a.rtmp.youtube.com/live2 or via a link posted on our website at ntcd.org.

CLARIFICATION ITEM 4: In the Special Technical Provisions under Section 170, Clearing and Grubbing, the per square footage cost shall include any costs associated with removing trees, shrubs, and vegetation not already shown on the plans as removed by others. The only trees that will be removed prior to the contract are the 31 pines, firs, and aspens shown on sheet C-1 with an "X."

CLARIFICATION ITEM 5: In the Special Technical Provisions under Section 175, Removal of Existing Improvements, the lump sum bid shall include the following existing improvements: chain link fencing as shown on the plans, the playground equipment, the flagpole and concrete block on the site, the concrete block associated with the bear proof trash can, and the NV energy power substation that is decommissioned near the irrigation controls. If the bid alternate item is awarded the contractor is responsible for both removal and disposal of the items identified as existing improvements.
